ACADEMIC CHECK-OUT FOR GRADUATION

All students in the College of Arts and Sciences must come to Scates Hall 107 to file their Intent to Graduate forms as soon as they reach senior status (90 hours or more). Students are encouraged to file their intent two semesters before their intended graduation date. Once the forms are completed, the graduation analyst will complete the Summary of Coursework Remaining form and will mail copies to the student and to the advisor.
